



1.1. Open the Command Prompt


1.1.1. Press the windows key on keyboard or click the Start icon.



1.1.2. input cmd and the Command Prompt program will show on the screen




1.1.3. Right click on the Command Prompt and Click the Run as administrator.




1.2. Login to MySQL and run update statement.


1.2.2. Input "mysql -uroot -pdoc50tracker" and press enter to start login MySQL.

root is the login user id and doc50tracker is login password .








